A meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Wauneta, Nebraska, was convened in open and public session at 6:30 p.m. on **December 12, 2023**, at the Wauneta Village Office.

Pledge of Allegiance was given.

Chairman Johnston publicly stated to all in attendance that a current copy of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was available for review.

Present: B Kramer, C Walgren, P Johnston. B Goings arrived at 6:34pm and R Einspahr arrived at 6:42pm.

Guests: RaNae Richardson (WCTC)

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the Imperial Republican on December 7, 2023. Notice of this meeting was simultaneously given to the Chairman and all the Trustees. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Board approved the minutes of the regular meeting of the Village Board of Trustees, held on November 14, 2023, and the special meeting held on November 29, 2023.

Board approved the Treasurer's Report (Nov) and approved bills (Dec) as presented.

Board approved Resolution No. 2023-05, a resolution to authorize signing the Year-End Certification of Street Superintendent (Greg Wolford).

The Board reviewed the Chase County Sheriff's Report for Nov 2023.

Board approved an invoice, in the amount of \$151,600.00, payable to Maguire Iron, for the cleaning and painting of the Water Tower Reservoir.

Board member Einspahr introduced Ordinance No. 2023-04, an ordinance to amend the Wauneta Zoning Ordinance to revise the maximum lot coverage for certain uses in the Residential District. Clerk Skelton read the Ordinance by title:

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE WAUNETA VILLAGE ZONING ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM LOT COVERAGE FOR CERTAIN USES WITHIN THE RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT AND TO INCREASE THE MAXIMUM TOTAL LOT COVERAGE OF ALL BUILDINGS AND ATTACHED STRUCTURES WITHIN THE RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT.

Board approved that the Statutory Rule requiring reading on three different days be suspended for consideration of said Ordinance; and approved that Ordinance No. 2023-04 be passed and adopted.

Board approved the purchase of a 2023 Spartan 72" mower, from Country Load Trailer Sales, in the amount of \$11,995.00.

Goings, Einspahr and RaNae Richardson reported on the Nursing Home Committee meeting, including review of the Oct 2023 Financial Reports.

The Board discussed the employer contribution for health insurance for WCTC employees and confirmed the 65% employer contribution.

Board approved Christmas bonuses for Nursing Home employees based on Richardson's recommendation, with the addition of including a bonus for RaNae Richardson.

Board approved Village employee Christmas bonuses, to be paid in Wauneta Chamber Bucks.

Board approved a Resolution to open an account with D.A. Davidson, and to designate and authorize Johnston and Skelton to act on behalf of the Village.

Skelton and Lawless gave an update on Nuisance properties within the Village.

Turkey-Bacon-Corn Chowder

- 1 lb Thick sliced bacon strips chopped
- 3 celery ribs sliced
- 1 medium onion chopped
- 1 medium carrot chopped
- % Cup chopped red pepper
- 1 Bay leaf
- % cup flour
- 32 oz chicken stock


- 1 can cream of chicken soup
- 8 oz cream cheese, softened
- % cup milk-2%
- % cup heavy whipping cream
- 3 ½ cups frozen corn
- 2 ½ cups cooked cubed turkey
- 2 cups refrigerated hash browns-10 oz
- % cup turkey gravy
- 1 TBSP dried parsley flakes

Cook bacon, add next 5 ingredients, cook 8-10 minutes over med heat. Stir in flour that is whisked in chicken stock. Boil. Add soup, cream cheese, milk, and cream, mix well. Stir in remaining ingredients with the bacon mixture, reduce heat. Cook covered 20 minutes, stirring occasionally. Can add minced garlic to vegetable mixture if you would like.
